Pakistan’s power crisis cripple Sindh education offices, leaving public services collapsed

KARACHI: Persistent electricity outages have paralysed several key education department offices in Sindh, severely disrupting administrative work, online services and public dealings for nearly three weeks despite officials maintaining that all electricity bills have been cleared, as reported by The Express Tribune.

According to The Express Tribune, the crisis has affected the offices of the Directorate General Colleges Sindh, the Regional Directorate Government Colleges Sindh and the Regional Directorate Private Schools Karachi. Officials said prolonged power cuts during working hours have brought routine government functions to a near standstill.

The disruption has significantly impacted online registration of private schools, issuance of computerised certificates, complaint redressal mechanisms and admission-related work for government colleges. Officials said computer systems,



internet connectivity and printing services remain unavailable for long periods due to the recurring outages, making it difficult to process essential public services.

Among the worst-hit facilities is the Directorate of Inspection and Registration of Private Institutions, where employees have struggled to maintain

normal operations. Officials stated that electricity is typically unavailable between 11 am and 2 pm and again after 4 pm, leaving offices with only three to four hours of power during an eight-hour workday. Deputy Director of Inspections said the prolonged outages have severely undermined the department's digital operations. He noted that

despite clearing all electricity dues and repeatedly contacting K-Electric through formal complaints and official correspondence, the situation has remained unchanged.

The ongoing disruption has also affected the admission process in government colleges across Sindh. Teachers, students, parents, school

owners and principals visiting the offices for admissions, registrations and other official work have reportedly faced long delays, with many forced to leave without receiving the required services, as cited by The Express Tribune. Officials further said the power crisis has impacted all three floors of the office building. The absence of electricity has left fans and air-conditioning systems non-functional, creating extreme heat and uncomfortable working conditions that have forced employees to continue their duties outdoors, as reported by The Express Tribune.

Trump’s teleprompter operator under federal probe over possible insider trading: White House

WASHINGTON : The White House on Thursday (local time) confirmed that US President Donald Trump’s long-time teleprompter operator is under a federal investigation over alleged insider trading on a prediction market platform, noting that the individual has been placed on unpaid administrative leave. Responding to a question during a press briefing, White House Press Secretary Karoline Leavitt said President Trump was aware of the matter and described the allegations as “deeply unfortunate”. “Obviously, I’m aware of the report. The President is too. I spoke with him about it. He believes it’s deeply unfortunate and frankly a disgrace, and the individual that was cited in that report is complying with the CFTC but has been put on unpaid administrative leave. So there will be a teleprompter operator tonight, of course, but it will not be the one, unfortunately in that story,” Leavitt said. She added that the White House maintains strict ethical standards and said the decision



to place the employee on leave was made by the President. “Well, the White House has extremely strict ethical guidelines with respect to issues like this, and as I just told you, this individual will no longer be here. He’ll be on administrative leave without pay. The administrative leave is unpaid, to be very clear. That was a decision by the President, so I think that speaks for itself,” Leavitt added. According to CNN, the US Commodity Futures Trading Commission (CFTC) is investigating White House employee Gabriel Perez, Trump’s long-time teleprompter operator, over potential insider trading on prediction market platform Kalshi.

CNN reported, citing

sources familiar with the matter, that Perez allegedly placed trades on Kalshi’s “mention markets”, where users wager on which words or phrases public figures, including the President, will use in speeches and public appearances. The trades were reportedly flagged by Kalshi’s internal surveillance team and referred to the CFTC for investigation. According to CNN, Perez allegedly made more than USD 90,000 in profits from the trades, though those profits have since been frozen. CNN reported that Perez has cooperated with the CFTC probe. A CFTC spokesperson told the network the agency could “neither confirm nor deny” an investigation.

Perez has worked closely with Trump for nearly a decade and is regarded as one of the President’s most trusted aides. According to CNN, his official title is Deputy Assistant to the President and Technical Advisor, with an annual salary of USD 175,000. He is often among the last people to review Trump’s prepared remarks before they are delivered publicly.

US announces visa restrictions targeting foreign nationals linked to “far-left terrorist” networks

WASHINGTON : The United States Department of State on Thursday (local time) announced a new visa restriction policy targeting foreign nationals accused of supporting, financing, recruiting for, or facilitating activities linked to far-left terrorist and aligned groups. US Secretary of State Marco Rubio announced the policy, saying the measures were aimed at preventing individuals who support or enable political violence from entering the United States.

“Today, State Department is imposing new visa restrictions to bar Far-Left Terrorists from entering our country.

Foreigners who finance, incite, or aid and abet Far-Left Terrorists are enemies of our civilisation. They are not welcome in the United States,” Rubio said in a post on X. The State Department said the move was taken in support of National Security Presidential Memo-



randum-7 and broader US government efforts to disrupt networks involved in political violence before they escalate into criminal activity.

According to the department, the policy will apply to members of far-left terrorist and aligned groups who have supported or incited acts of terrorism, backed violent criminal activity, participated in economic sabotage, financed or recruited individuals for violent actions, provided logistical support, or helped coordinate networks for violent activities.

The restrictions are being implemented under Section

212(a)(3)(C) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, which allows the US to deny entry to foreign nationals whose presence could have serious adverse foreign policy consequences.

The announcement came following a State Department ministerial on the resurgence of political terrorism, which brought together representatives from 67 countries, according to a State Department spokesperson. Addressing the ministerial in Washington, Rubio said the primary responsibility of any government was the protection of its people and country.

“JUST A HINT AT WHAT IS WHAT AND WHO IS WHO”: BAGHAEI SLAMS US, ISRAEL AND ARGENTINA OVER “REVEALING” UNGA VOTING TRENDS

TEHRAN: Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesperson Esmail Baghaei on Thursday drew attention to what he characterised as a “revealing” trend in recent United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) voting records, noting a recurring alignment between the United States, Israel, and Argentina. In a post on X, Baghaei highlighted a series of UNGA resolutions where these three nations stood as the only countries to vote in opposition to the majority. The resolutions he cited include the ninth review of the Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy adopted on July 1, 2026, a March 25, 2026, resolution recognising the transatlantic slave trade as the “gravest crime against humanity”, as well as earlier measures regarding human rights and human trafficking adopted in December 2025. By emphasising that these nations were the sole dissenting voices in each of these instances, Baghaei suggested that such voting patterns offer significant insight into the geopolitical priorities of the countries
